In both of these examples, many or all of the exposed cells experience a similar change in response to radiation. A second class of change includes those alterations that differ from one cell to another. A wide variety of possible discrete changes, such as mutations, is possible. Any single cell may or may not have experienced one or another of the changes, and the probability of finding a cell with a specific change would be expected to be dose-dependent. Such changes resulting from exposures to UV-irradiation and chemicals include mutations that are the result of DNA damage or flawed...
