About 125 subjects, or 250 frontal sinuses, obtained from dissectingroom material, form the basis of this research. They were inspected when obtained, and preserved in alcohol for future study and reference. Fifty of these specimens were macerated, after examination, in the natural state, and about fifty more bony specimens have been accessible for study. The parts have been examined from sagittal, coronal, and horizontal sections, and also by dissection of especial regions, the use of probes, injection of fluids, etc. The accompanying plates were made from photographs taken by Bernard W. Trafford, Esq., of Boston, whose assistance and skill were invaluable in adding to the success of the work. These photographs were taken from specimens selected as seemed necessary to demonstrate the anatomy under consideration, hence the relations are an...
