

Roughly speaking, calico printing may be divided into four sections: 1. Direct printing, in which the pattern is printed directl-y on the cloth and is sub sequently fixed by means of steaming, oxidizing or reducing. 2. Combined dyeing and printing in which the mordant is printed on the cloth and thereafter is aged and cleared. 3. Discharge printing in which either a mordant is printed on the white cloth which takes certain dyed effects, or a solvent is printed which actually discharges the previously dyed color, according to the required design. 4. Resist or reserve printing in which a design is printed on the cloth by means of a chemical preparation which resists or refuses to take the subsequent dyeing, thus leaving a figured pattern on the dyed fabric. tration of the liquor and so producing when unbound, a variety of fantastic effects. This was the precursor of a method of dyeing which is even now used and which is known as the Tied and Dyed process. Another development was the tracing of designs by means of fused wax and subsequently dyeing. This also was the ancient ancestor of a method which has again come into popular esteem, and is known as the Batik process. After dyeing, the wax was removed leaving an uncolored design on the dyed goods. This...
